Badgerbrook Library

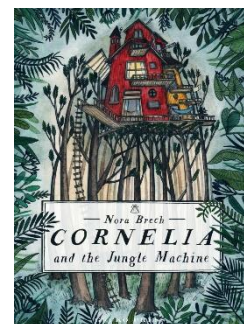
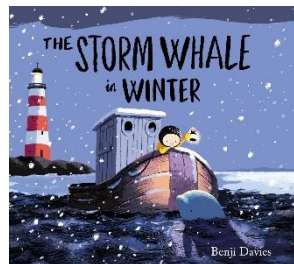

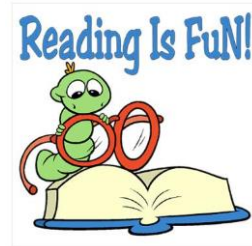


Look out for author of the month/ book of the week chosen by our children next time!
