In Communication and Language we will:

Listen to stories, accurately anticipating key events and responds to what they hear.
Follow instructions and answer how and why questions.
Develop our own narratives and explanations by connecting ideas.

In Physical Development we will:

Negotiate space successfully when playing racing and chasing games.
Move confidently in a range of ways.
Uses a pencil and hold it effectively to form recognisable letters which are correctly formed.

In Personal, Social, Emotional Development we will:

Read and write some red words.
Write letters to communicate meaning.
Attempt to write short sentences.
Use our phonics knowledge to write words.
Spell some words correctly and others will be phonetically plausible.

In Mathematics we will:

Count reliably with numbers 0-20.
Recognise and order teen numbers.
Use part, part whole models.
Use ten frames.
Add and subtract numbers.
Record and explain our thinking.
Say what one more and one less of a number is to 20.

In Understanding the world we will:

Look at similarities and differences between living things in the sea and the jungle.
Make observations of the seed I planted.
Select and use technology for different purposes.

Expressive arts and design we will:

Sing songs and join in with the wake and shake dances.
Use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques to make a junk modelling scene.
