In Communication and Language we will:

Listen to stories, accurately anticipating key events and responds to what they hear.
Use past, present and future forms accurately when talking about events.
Develop our own narratives and explanations by connecting ideas.

In Physical Development we will:

Move confidently in a range of ways.
Uses a pencil and hold it effectively to form recognisable letters which are correctly formed.
Know and talk about the importance for good health and physical exercise and a healthy diet.

Read and write some red words.
Attempt to write short sentences.
Spell some words correctly and others will be phonetically plausible.

In Mathematics we will:

Count reliably with numbers 0-20.
Add and subtract numbers.
Say what one more and one less of a number is to 20.
Solve problems, including doubling, halving and sharing.

In Understanding the world we will:

Talk about past and present events in our lives.
Look at similarities and differences.
Select and use technology for different purposes.

Expressive arts and design we will:

Use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques experimenting with colour, design, texture to make our own super hero.
Represent our own ideas, thoughts and feelings in different ways.
