Dear Parents & Carers

Following the Prime Minister's address at 8pm this evening, unfortunately, we are unable to open the school to any pupil tomorrow. From tomorrow we have to move to remote learning for all pupils and we need Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January to organise the structure and logistics of offering places in school commencing Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> January. Places in school will be offered following this criteria:

- Pupils with an EHCP
- Vulnerable pupils as identified by the school and the Local Authority
- Single parent households where the parent is a key worker (evidence from your employer will be required)
- Pupils where **both parents** in the same household are key workers (evidence from your employer will be required)

If you feel that your child is eligible for a place in school please email [office@badgerbrook.leics.sch.uk](mailto:office@badgerbrook.leics.sch.uk) with details of how you meet the above criteria. The deadline for these emails is **noon** tomorrow. The Governing Body will be meeting to agree the plan and finalise places. We will then notify you by email before 6pm on Tuesday if your child has been allocated a place.

**Following the government guidelines it is absolutely essential that if your child can stay at home you do not request a place in school.**

Details of our revised remote learning will also be sent out tomorrow.

I'm sure you can appreciate that we have only just heard the details of the national lockdown and are having to change our plans overnight. Until 8pm we were planning to be open to all pupils tomorrow.

Thank you for your patience and understanding in these challenging times.
