

Badgerbrook Primary School - Lunchtime Charter



CHILDREN:

- Respect lunchtime supervisors and other children – be considerate and polite
- Listen to adults and each other – don't argue with decisions made
- Walk in the hall – don't run or push
- Line up properly – don't push in front of each other
- Use a sensible voice level – don't shout in the hall
- Say please and thank you
- Have good table manners – don't talk with food in your mouth
- Clean your tray properly
- If trays are dirty hand them to kitchen staff
- Use bands sensibly – no flicking or chewing
- If you drop something pick it up or let an adult know
- Sit properly on your chair – stack your chair carefully
- Take your coats off when eating (unless a very cold day)
- Try to eat all of your lunch – finish your lunch before you go out

ADULTS:

- Respect each other and the children
- Give out stickers for good behaviour
- Praise good role models
- Provide a safe environment – keep the floor clean
- Model good table manners
- Give out stickers for good choices

CHILDREN:

- Be respectful to adults and each other
- Play sensibly and fairly – no physical play
- Keep your hands and feet to yourself
- Follow instructions
- Stop and listen when the whistle goes
- Don't interrupt other children's games
- Don't interfere with other children's friendships
- Treat the environment with respect
- Put all litter in the bin
- Treat equipment properly
- Always get permission to get equipment out

ADULTS:

- Try to help resolve friendship issues
- Provide a variety of games/ activities
- Give out stickers for good choices
