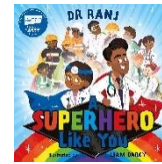




Foundation Spring Term Big Question

Here is the Big Picture for our work for the Spring second half term.

In Communication and Language we will:

Engage in fiction and non-fiction books
Listen to stories about superheroes and comment on what we have heard.
Use recently introduced vocabulary when talking about superheroes.
Try to explain our thinking to others.
Learn rhymes, poems and songs

In Personal, Social, Emotional Development we will:

Express their feelings and consider the feelings of others.
Follow instructions involving several steps.
Develop confidence, independence and resilience when working with others.
Understand the importance for healthy food choices.
Talk about the internet safety rules, revisiting Dooby Wop.

In Physical Development we will:

Travel on, over, under, around apparatus in gymnastics
Begin to show accuracy when drawing pictures.
Hold our pencils carefully to improve our handwriting.
Use tools such as scissors, knives, paintbrushes more accurately.

In Literacy we will:

Retell stories, using new vocabulary
Use recently introduced vocabulary during role-play.
Read simple sentences including some red words.
Learn to read and write more digraphs.
Try to form our letters correctly.
Spell words by identifying the sounds and then writing the sounds we hear.
Write independently about superheroes in simple sentences using known sounds.
Begin to write short sentences using a capital letter and full stop.

In Mathematics we will:

Explore the composition of numbers to 10.
Write numbers using the correct formation.
Begin to learn number bonds to 10.
Begin to orally count beyond 20.
Create repeating patterns.

In Understanding the world we will:

Talk about real life superheroes and their roles in society.
Understand the difference between fact and fiction.

Expressive arts and design we will:

Use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques experimenting with colour, design, texture to make our own veggie superhero.
Create collaboratively and share ideas then talk about traps that we have made for villains.
Make and use props when role playing.
Invent and develop storylines when role playing with others.
